### January 5th-

Title- The Birthright

Focus Passage— Genesis 25:21-34
Secondary Passage— Matthew 3:13-17
Synopsis— Isaac's wife, Rebekah, has twin boys.
Their names are Essau and Jacob. The birthright belongs to Essau, but he sells his birthright for a bowl of soup. The Lord chose Jacob and it is through him he will bring about redemption. God has chosen you, claimed you, and marked you as

his own. You don't have to fight your way to the top.

### January 12th

Title - Who is It?

Focus Passage – Genesis 27:18-34
Secondary Passage – James 1:16-18
Synopsis – Rebekah knows that the Lord has chosen Jacob, but Isaac loved Essau. She devises a plan to make sure that Jacob receives the blessing of his father. Through scheming and deceit Isaac will bless Jacob. In the Old Testament blessings aren't just nice things, they shape and form our lives. We all want to be blessed and sometimes we deceive others into giving it to us.

### **SERMON SERIES**

### Jacob-Wrestling with God

Jacob's name means striver, schemer, or hustler. Born to Isaac, the grandson of Abraham, his story is one of a constant battle with God. Like Jacob, we wrestle with God. We don't have to hustle God to get a better life. Here's the thing, God doesn't need our striving to climb the ladder. He comes to us and lifts us up to a place we belong.

### January 19th

Title - "The House of the Lord"

Focus Passage – Genesis 28:10-22

Secondary Passage – Luke 19:41-48

Synopsis – In a dream Jacob experiencing the presence of God. There he receives the promise, "I am the Lord, the God of your father Abraham and Isaac. All peoples on earth will be blessed through you." It was the same promise given to Abraham. Though there is no temple, Jacob names that place Bethel, which means the House of the Lord. It's not about where or what we worship, but who we worship.

#### January 26th

Title- "Love and Deceit"

Focus Passage – Genesis 29:15-35
Secondary Passage – Romans 5:1-8
Synopsis – Jacob wants to marry Rachel, but
Laben deceives him and gives him his oldest
daughter, Leah, instead. After 7 years of labor, the
deceiver has been deceived. God will bring good
from Laben's deceit and Leah's longing for love.
Though Jacob loved another, God will bring forth a
king and a savior from Leah. Our deepest longings
can only be satisfied by the love of Jesus.


